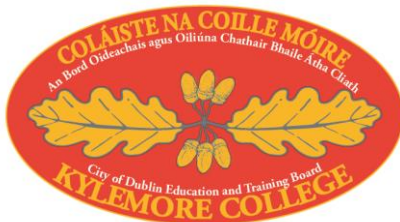

Start times

New Covid – 19 Uniform policy
